2701 <u>Declarations of Interest</u>

There were no declarations of interest.

2702 Community Police Matters

There was no police presence at tonight's meeting. The Clerk reported that the March Pact Meeting had been cancelled due to a School Concert on the same night. He said that he had tried to obtain and alternative date but this had not been suitable to the Police. They had therefore said that they would not hold another Pact Meeting until the pre-arranged May Meeting.

2703 County Borough Councillors Report

The Clerk informed that he had received a message from C.B Cllr. Leanne Jones who had been held up in another meeting. She tendered her apologies. He said that if anyone had any issues he would pass them on to the C.B. Cllr.

2705 Matters Arising

The Clerk said that the Notice Boards were now complete and distributed keys to the Councillors that needed them. He also said that he would in due course be placing fixing pins in the boards for use by the people who would be posting notices etc. At this point Cllr. Christine Harper once again stated her dissatisfaction with the boards. She said that she felt that the quality was below standard and wished it to be recorded that in future a complete specification should be agreed.

2707 Playgrounds

It was confirmed that a sub-committee meeting had not been held during the past month which was mainly due to the fact that Cllr. Darren Harrison had broken his ankle. He said that he was now able to get about and asked the Clerk to see if there was availability at the School, for a meeting on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> April at 7.00 pm. Various new ideas were mentioned including conversion of the "tennis courts" at Tonna RFC and the possibility of a skateboard unit at Dan Y Bryn but it was decided that these should be further discussed by the Playground Sub-committee at their forthcoming meeting. Thereafter, final

recommendations should be brought forward the full Council in due course.

#### 2708 Wish List

The Clerk informed that there were no items left on the wish list. Various new subjects were then mentioned, including the latest position regarding the trees at the boundary of the new housing site, the "sink" hole at Tonna RFC and finally the possibility of a retirement gift for Mrs. Enfys Evans. The Clerk once again explained that Community funds could not be used to pay for a gift for any retiring member but individual donations could be used. At this point it was proposed by Cllr. Mrs. Johanne Barnes that an agreed monetary contribution be given by each member of the Council and a gift bought for Mrs. Evans. This was seconded by Cllr. Huw Bradley and approved by the members. Mrs Harper volunteered to collect the money and organise the gift.

## 2712 Accounts Monitoring

He presented the meeting with a resolution which removed the names of Councillors who were no longer members and replaced by the new Councillors. It was proposed by Cllr. Huw Bradley and seconded by Cllr. Simon Radford that the resolution be approved. This was carried by the meeting and then signed by the Chair and the Proper Officer for delivery to the Bank. The Clerk also advised the meeting that he had received the Annual Return documentation for the External Auditors, BDO and he would be actively working on them in due course. He also said that whilst it was not compulsory, it would be desirable if the Internal Auditor would give a short presentation upon completion of his audit. He said he would contact him with this proposal.
