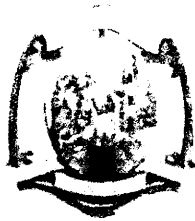

2822 Declarations of Interest

2823 Community Police Matters

2824 County Borough Councillors Report

The County Borough Councillor was not present at tonight's meeting so there was no C.B. Cllr's Report.

2827 Delegates Reports

The Clerk referred to the Best Dressed House and reported that the winner had been the Isaac family in Dolcoed. He said that the Chair had delivered the Voucher for £25

He also was able to report that the Christmas tree and lights had been dismantled by twelfth night

2828 Playgrounds

The Clerk reported that weather permitting Wicksteed would be starting work on the playground project at the end of the month.

2829 Civic Service

The Clerk issued the Councillors with official invitations to the Civic Service which was scheduled for Sunday 16th February. He said that he and the Chair would be finalising the details of the service during the very near future.

2830 Wish List

The Clerk said that the Notice Board at Dan Y Bryn had been vandalised but had now been repaired. Cllr. Mrs Christine Harper said that she was still not happy with the Notice Boards and asked the Councillors to look at them and consider ordering 2 new metal boards. Cllr Darren Harrison asked if Notice Boards could be added to the agenda for the next meeting so that a full discussion could be had.

The Clerk said that NPTCBC had at least began to install new street signs. He said that he had seen a new sign for Parkfield being installed today.

He said that he was not able to report progress on the land issue at Dan Y Bryn or the bank situation.

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2833 Accounts Monitoring

The Clerk reported that there were 3 items for this month as follows,

1. Monitor the Budget The Clerk issued the members with copies of the budget as it stand for the end of December. Most of the items were well within budget with only a slight under situation with regards to miscellaneous items. This was approved by the meeting.
2. Quarterly Bank Reconciliation. The Clerk issued the members with copies of the Bank Reconciliation for the end of December. This was approved by the meeting.
3. Precept The Clerk confirmed that he had notified NPTCBC of the Precept requirement for 2020 – 2021 as being £38,000.

2834 Financial Matters

The Clerk told the meeting that there had been a cheque made out for Castell Nedd Chess Club in July which had not been cashed. He said that upon speaking to the organiser, he confirmed that they had not received our cheque. The meeting agreed that the missing cheque should be cancelled at the bank and a new cheque for £50 sent off to them.

The Clerk reminded the Council that each year the Church provided the power for our Christmas Tree lights and that it was customary to make a donation for the cost. Cllr Bill Walters proposed that the usual amount of £100 be paid to St Anne's. This was seconded by Cllr Colin Powell and approved by the meeting.

With regard to the Councillors £150 payments, the Clerk also informed the members that they would have to opt in or opt out in writing. He said that forms would be provided at the next meeting for consideration by everyone.
