3060 Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest.

3061 County Borough Councillors Report

There was no report.

3062 The minutes of the meeting held on 13th July, 2021 were accepted as a correct record.

3063 **Matters Arising**

There were no matters arising.

3064 **Delegates Reports**

The Chair reported that he, together with the County Borough Councillor and Councillor Ms. Johanne Barnes had delivered the prizes for the recent Tonna in Bloom competition. The winners were; for best garden - Mr. John Boden and best Sunflower - Miss Delyth Harry. He said that both recipients were delighted with their prizes of £25 voucher donated by the Council and C. B Councillor Leanne Jones.

The Clerk said that a lovespoon had been purchased for Mr John Prichard who unfortunately died a few days before his 90th birthday. He said that as the lovespoon had been purchased and engraved, it was given to his son as a memento. Mr Prichard Jnr was suitably impressed and said that his father would have been delighted.

3065 **Playgrounds**

As the County Borough Councillor was not in attendance tonight, the Clerk was asked to contact her for an up-to-date report to be delivered at the next meeting, on the status of the s106 money designated for Tonna following the completion of the new housing site.

3066 **Notice Board**

The Clerk reminded the members of the conditions required by NPTCBC for a licence to site the proposed new notice board opposite the Whittington. The general consensus of opinion was that the Council was unwilling to pay the required licence fee and would therefor choose a different site. Noddfa Newydd and Lock Hill were the two preferred sites and after discussion it was proposed by Cllr. Ms. Johanne Barnes that the new site should be Noddfa Newydd. This was seconded by Cllr Bill Walters and approved by the members. The Clerk will try to obtain up to date prices for the materials for final discussion at the next meeting.

3067 Wish List

The Clerk informed the Council that Cllr. Martyn Lyddon had managed to obtain a new fireproof cabinet for the Council at a price of £400.00. He said that the Council should thank Cllr Lyddon for his efforts. The Cabinet was "as new" and was original priced in excess of £1,400.00. Our local countryside contractor had collected the cabinet from Bridgend and delivered and installed it in the school at a cost of £60.00.

The Clerk said that the two replacement bird boxes had been delivered to Mr Michael Hughes. He had installed one and was waiting to see if they were vandalised before installing the second. Cllr Colin Powell had purchased bird seed and delivered it to Mr Hughes.

Regarding Tonna RFC Limited, the Clerk informed that a new lease had been drawn up and was in the process of being completed by both parties.

The Clerk said that the new all-weather leaflet boxes had been delivered to Cllr Martyn Lyddon who had installed them. He said that they were being well used.

3068 Correspondence

Tonna Juniors AFC

Cllr. S. Radford declared an interest. It was explained that due to Covid the local Junior Football League were now holding their matches on a group basis but in order to have the benefit of home games needed another set of goals to facilitate four teams to play at a time. Otherwise Tonna would have to play away games only. This would involve additional expense etc. After an in depth discussion it was proposed by Cllr. Ms. Johanne Barnes and seconded by Cllr Martyn Lyddon that the price for the goals be paid by the Council. This was approved by the meeting.

St. Anne's Church

A request was made to purchase a small area of Astroturf for the area in front of the Tonna Memorial as the existing area was in a very poor condition. This artificial turf could then be laid down for special occasions particularly for Remembrance Sunday. The cost would be circa £120.00. Cllr Bill Walters proposed that the funding be given by the Council. This was seconded by Cllr Simon Radford and approved by the Council.

Mrs. Lloyd requested permission to site a seat in a convenient position at Tonna Rugby Club in memory of her recently departed husband who was a life member of the club. It was proposed by Cllr. Bill Walters and seconded by Cllr Martyn Lyddon that permission be granted. This was approved by the Council.
