3402 Apologies

3403 Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest.

3404 Councillor's Resignation

The Clerk reported that all of the due diligence including posting of notices had been carried out with no requests to be considered for the vacant post. He said that it was now down to the members to try to find a suitable replacement at which time they can be co-opted on to the Council.

3405 Police

There was no Police presence at tonight's meeting.

3406 County Borough Councillors Report

There was no County Borough Councillors report.

The Clerk said that he had contacted Cllr. Jones regarding the need for a signpost directing walkers and tourists to the Brunel Woodland Walk.
