3636 Apologies

There were no apologies for absence.

3637 Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest.

3638 Police

There was no Police presence at the meeting.

3639 Playground Project

The Clerk reminded the members that NPTCBC would be considering the Councils grant application tomorrow, 13th November. He also reminded the meeting that Hags had agreed to extend the validity of their offer until this week. He said that if there was a positive result he would like to place an order on Hags immediately. If this was the case Hags required a period of time to organise and set up the project and he would assume that actual site work would probably commence in January.

3640 County Borough Councillors Report

County Borough Councillor Leanne Jones was not in attendance due to her need to be in Basingstoke for three days. The Clerk said that she had attended the Remembrance Service at St Anne's Church on Sunday and laid a wreath. She also provided more information regarding water butts and the noisy manhole in Henfaes Road.

3643 Delegates Reports

Daffodils It was proposed by Clir Martyn Lyddon that a further 500 daffodils be

purchased and placed around the village. This was seconded by Clir Ms Johanne Barnes and approved by the members. The Clerk will

contact suppliers and arrange the best available deal.

Defibrillators The Clerk reported that he had contacted Heartbeat Wales Trust who

said that they were regularly inspecting and if necessary, maintaining the village Defibrillators. They also promised to look into the third defibrillator which originally was to be sited near the new Cwm Celyn

site.

The Clerk confirmed that he now had completed the legal document with NPTCBC.

Cllr Michael Rowlands informed of the lighting up and shutting down of the lights being switch on 6th December and off on 7th January.
